Psalm 51 is David's confession of his sin with Bathsheba. David to be cleansed, confesses his sin, asks to be forgiven and restored, and pledges to love and serve God. Verses 16 and 17 describe the sacrifices David knows God desires and his promise to offer them. Read these two verses before discussing the following questions.

What does God really want? What is the motivation behind a proper sacrifice?

What do you need to sacrifice to our Father? How will you do this?

PRAYER

Spend this time discerning how best pray for one another. Praise God for one specific item and petition Him for one request on their behalf.

Thank God for providing such faithful Community Group leaders. Ask Him to continue bringing people to Himself and allowing TCBC to walk alongside them.
