Protecting the gospel of grace means that we ...

1. appeal to God alone as the basis of authority.

1:18-19

Application: center our spiritual formation in God's word.

2. adore God when we see His grace at work in others.

1:20-24

Application: celebrate God's grace whenever we see it.

3. attempt to live in unity with other believers.

2:1-2

Application: consider grace as central to living in Christ.
